



Sasrapid Eligibility Policy and Procedure

Policy

Activities promoted and supported by Sasrapid Incorporated enable the inclusion of participants living with disability into a myriad of sport, recreation and leisure activities. Activities are available to any person living with disability (*intellectual or other disability*). Sasrapid enables people living with disability to compete in ability-based competition or individual activity. The inclusion of people living with disability is achieved by a variety of methods including parallel programming.

The participant must be an Active Member of Sasrapid to receive support from Sasrapid for their chosen supported or promoted activity.

National and International

For a person with an intellectual disability to be deemed eligible to represent their State or Country in National or International competition, a person must be assessed as having an intellectual disability, as per requirements of INAS (International Sport Federation for People with an Intellectual Disability). State and National eligibility is processed by Ausrapid via the Sasrapid Office.
